The Council received a copy of the minutes of the April meeting of the Community Centre subcommittee. Cllr Sampher reported that the task of fitting out the different rooms in the new building had been delegated to members of the committee.

Cllr Sampher noted that there will be a small play area at the rear of the Community Centre. This will need to be maintained by the Parish Council. It was **RESOLVED** to ask Westmere Homes to install equipment for smaller children as there is already sufficient equipment for older children at the main play area.

24 Flooding Report

The Council had not received an update re publication of Norfolk County Council's flooding report. Cllr Bowes will chase.

25 Road adoptions at Blenheim Grange

Cllr Wormall noted that the Residents Association had been in contact with Anglian Water. Anglian Water confirmed that the work had been delegated to the Drainage Development Manager. It was noted that the consortium had reported that Anglian Water had promised to look at the file for the Section 102 agreement (the adoption of the sewers). Cllr Wormall noted that Anglian Water had told him it was waiting for a report from the consortium and has requested further information. Anglian Water's part of the work should be concluded within about two months.

The consortium had told the Parish Council that a price was awaited for the Wessex Road design in terms of the new street lighting design. Cllr Bowes will check progress.

Cllr Wormall said the Residents Association will approach George Freeman with regard to the removal of the spoil heap, as the consortium has not as yet agreed its removal.
