## 8. Village Hall Car park/Millennium Green fence

The Council considered a request to repair the fence between the Village Hall car park and Millennium Green. It was noted that members of the Council had been told by former Trust members that the fence was owned by the Millennium Green Trust, although it was acknowledged there is no formal evidence of ownership.

#### 9. Summer Lane and Mill Lane

The Council considered the condition of Summer Lane and Mill Lane. It was unanimously RESOLVED to request Norfolk County Council to bring forward its resurfacing works in order to improve access to the village.

#### 10. Dog Bins at Blenheim Grange

It was unanimously RESOLVED to purchase a dog bin to be installed next to the footpath at the power substation.

#### 11. Clearance at front of Blenheim Grange

The Council had obtained quotes to clear two additional areas at the front of Blenheim Grange. It was unanimously RESOLVED to appoint Tom Duquesne.

#### 12. Tree Works at Ansen Way

The Council had obtained quotes to carry out works in the wooded area near Ansen Way in accordance to the Tree Survey. It was unanimously RESOLVED to appoint Tom Duquesne to carry out all high, medium and low risk works. The Council will be pursuing a policy of replanting.

#### 13. Rubbish at Ansen Way

The Council noted that items had been fly-tipped in the wooded area at Ansen Way. The Council had obtained quotes. It was unanimously RESOLVED to appoint Tom Duquesne.

#### 14. Ash Trees on Norwich Road

Norfolk County Council had informed the Council of an ash tree next to Norwich Road that needs significant deadwooding and another ash tree that needs to be felled. The Council had obtained quotes. It was unanimously RESOLVED to appoint Tom Duquesne.

#### 15. Proposals for Norfolk Day

The Council unanimously RESOLVED to set aside £250. It was unanimously RESOLVED to ask the school if it will organize an event.

## 16. Representatives' Reports

Cllr Borrett noted that half yearly invoices had been delivered by the Fuel Allotment charity.

Cllr Dekeyzer noted that plans regarding the works to the Village Hall Trust are currently uncertain.
